

The book explores powerful themes including:


- Finding God's presence in the midst of suffering

Rising Above Chronic Pain and Illness

These questions are designed to help podcast hosts facilitate meaningful conversations about Carolyn's journey through chronic pain and the biblical truths found in *Embers of Endurance*.

1. Carolyn, your book is titled *Embers of Endurance*—can you explain the significance of that metaphor and what it means to rise from the ashes of chronic pain?
2. You write that “God gives us more than we can bear because He helps us bear it.” How did you come to this realization, and how does it challenge the common saying that God never gives us more than we can handle?
3. In your book, you emphasize shifting from “What if?” to “Even if.” Can you walk us through what that transformation looks like in the midst of a difficult diagnosis or chronic pain flare?
4. You describe pain as “the persistent reminder to pray persistently.” How has chronic illness changed your prayer life, and what would you say to listeners who feel their prayers aren't being answered?
5. One of your most powerful statements is “Pain afflicts me, but it doesn't control me.” How do you maintain that boundary between experiencing pain and letting it define you?
6. You've experienced moments when Jesus seemed late but was actually on time. Can you share a specific instance when God's timing challenged your understanding but ultimately revealed His faithfulness?
7. The book talks about the unique gifts of comfort Christ gives us through suffering. What are some of these gifts you've discovered that you might never have known without walking through pain?
8. You write, “When God is silent, He isn't still.” How do you recognize God's work during seasons when you can't see or feel His presence?
9. Many people struggling with chronic illness battle disappointment when their bodies force them to cancel plans. How do you navigate this “interrupted life” while maintaining hope?
